# Radiological Protection

- Radiological Emergency Preparedness
  - 3 power plants with 2 in the future
  - Partner with MSP and the counties
  - Utilize other staff to supplement team
- Radioactive Materials Program; TENORM
- Low Level Radiological Waste Authority
- Radon
