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

LUST

- Goal: Reduce backlog of 8000 plus open releases by 25% over 5 years (FY'22 FY'26)
 - EPA data evaluation of site database and release numbers
 - Consultant review of Part 213 implementation consistent with RBCA
 - Pilot projects to enhance triage of sites and use of contractors for closure
 - Engaged with petroleum industry regarding evaluation of historic site data collection to enhance data driven decision making
 - Database consolidation



Redevelopment

- Address issues identified regarding approval of response activity plans and documentation of due care
 - Due Care obligations
 - Clarity in process and expectations
 - Focus group to develop workshop
 - Michigan Housing Council, Detroit Housing Commission, MSHDA, Environmental Contractors



Program Clarity

- Consistent expectations for staff and regulated community
 - Dozens of retirements and personnel changes (loss of hundreds of years combined experience)
 - Updated 24 internal procedures
 - Conducted 44 staff trainings
 - Updated or created 12 external guidance documents and checklists to assist in meeting program requirements
 - Conducted 13 external webinars and training events
